


What's going on at the BCCA?



Directions to the B.C.C.A.

Brookline Community Center for the Arts
 14 Green Street
 Brookline, MA 02446

- Take Cambridge/Allston exit.
- Stay left after tolls, follow signs to Allston (Cambridge Street).
- Go through several lights and over bridge, to first light after bridge (Sports Depot on your right).
- Left at light onto Harvard Ave.
- Cross major intersections at Brighton Ave (1/4 mile) and Commonwealth Ave (1/2 mile) (Harvard Ave. turns into Harvard St.).
- Continue on Harvard St. about 1 mile further to Coolidge Corner.
- Since Green Street has a "no left", turn left one block before onto Babcock, and make first right to park.
- Otherwise, Cinema is on right, Green Street on left after Citizen's Bank.

The BCCA is located one block from intersection of Beacon St. and Harvard St. Just behind Citizen's Bank (bank is across the street from the Coolidge Corner Cinema).

The center is only one block from the **C Line (Coolidge Corner T-Stop)**.


The **B and D Lines** are within 10 minutes walking distance down Harvard Street.

- **B Line:** Get off at **Harvard St. T-Stop** and walk down Harvard St. away from Cambridge.

- **D Line:** Get off at **Brookline Village T-Stop** and walk down Harvard St. towards Cambridge.

The **Coolidge Corner Stop** on the **66 bus** stop is several blocks from the intersection of Harvard St. & Beacon St.

Metered and free parking are ample. (Avoid parking in residential overnight lots after 8:00 p.m.)



- Take Storrow Drive from I-93 to Fenway Exit/Kenmore Square (look for "Citgo" sign) Stay right at exit (it splits).
- Take first right and stay left onto Beacon Street, follow outbound about 1 mile to Coolidge Corner.
- Right on Harvard St.
- First right on Green Street before Citizen's Bank.
- BCCA is on left, make left at next intersection to parking.
